Also, this very personality belongs to the Scheduled caste (Namasudra). Dr. Biswas explores the socio-political dynamics of the Pod community during the colonial period. His monograph is based on textual studies and unravels the history of the 'Paundra' who possibly were significant competitors to Namasudra and Rajbansis in Bengal depressed caste politics. Additionally, Dr. Biswas has contributed to academic discussion on Dalit education. He examines the educational advancements made by the Pods in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Dr. Biswas's work provides valuable insights into the history and struggled of Dalit communities in Bengal, highlighting their efforts towards social mobility and education during the colonial era.
